NOTICE – LL.M. STUDENTS

Your attention is drawn to Ordinance of the University of Delhi for Promotion Rules "No student shall be promoted to the next Term, if he/she has been detained in the examination for shortage of attendance and/or non-submission of written paper in all the courses offered by him/her for class discussion and had failed to get certificate from the teacher teaching the course".

In this connection, it is also pointed out that LL.M. is considered equal to M.Phil. in Delhi University, the papers and dissertation by the LL.M. Students must also have the plagiarism check.

In terms of the above rules, all LL.M. 2 years and 3 years course as well as LL.M. (Comparative Law) students are advised to submit a printed copy of their class presentation with anti plagiarism certificate before the end of the semester. The admit cards for taking the exam will be issued only if such paper with the anti-plagiarism certificate duly signed by the teacher is received by the Dean's office in all the courses studied by the scholar.

Arrangements are being made to get the paper/dissertation checked for plagiarism in the Faculty of Law Library. The students are advised to contact the Librarian, Faculty of Law in this respect.
